

About SAT

SAT or Scholastic Aptitude Test is a standardized test conducted by the College board for international candidates aspiring to pursue undergraduate studies abroad, especially in the US. SAT exam has been developed to evaluate the written, verbal and mathematical skills of the candidates.

The College Board, which is the conducting body of the SAT, has not laid down any specific SAT eligibility criteria for students wanting to appear for the SAT exam. There is no minimum or maximum age criteria fixed for students wanting to appear for the exam.

SAT Exam Pattern

SAT exam pattern comprises of two major sections – Evidence-based Reading and Writing (EBRW) and Math. Both sections, EBRW and Math, are scored on a range of 200-800.

- Both sections of EBRW questions are multiple-choice questions.
- Math is divided into two sets of questions one to be attempted without using a calculator and one with a calculator.
- Most of the Mathematics questions are MCQs; some questions are grid-ins i.e. students must solve and fill in the answer on the bubble sheet.
- The exam is 3 hours long. There is a time limit of 100 minutes to attempt EBRW and 80 minutes for Math.



SAT EXAM SYLLABUS

Reading

- One literary passage from American or International work of fiction like short stories or novels.
- One passage or a pair of passages from U.S. founding documents or Great Global Conversation on topics like freedom, justice, and human dignity.
- A selection of passages on economics, psychology, sociology, etc.
- Two passages from the work of science.

Mathematics

- Heart of Algebra create, manipulate and solve algebraic equations like linear equations and systems.
- Problem Solving and Data Analysis interpret graphs and table and solve problems in realworld situations using ratios, percentages.

• Passport to Advanced Math - Work on, manipulate and solve complex mathematical equations and function.

Writing and Language

- Requires students to revise and edit passages.
- Topics explored are career, science, humanities, history, and social science.
- Passage writing modes are narrative, argumentative, and informative/explanatory.
- At least one passage on each of the above writing modes is present.


